Dear Sir,

Thank you for your letter of the 10th July 1974 and the enclosures. This office being the Department of the Accountant General of the Supreme Court maintains the records of all funds lodged in England and Wales.

Your letter contains no evidence to indicate that funds were ever lodged in Court, and it should be realised that not all unclaimed money comes to the attention of the Court, nevertheless from the information you have given I have had a search of my records. This has revealed the following account :-

Solomon - Re Solomon's Estate Adams v Solomon 1867 S 259.

The account was opened by the lodgment of £491.7.4 into Court in 1868. The bulk of this money was ultimately paid leaving a balance of £118.1.11 remaining in court. To whom this sum is due I am unable to say, and whether this account is in any way connected with the subject of your enquiry would appear doubtful.

Individual names are seldom sufficient to trace an account. In order to positively identify a fund it is normally necessary to furnish the title of the account to which the fund is standing, or the date of the Court Order which directed lodgment to be made or the year and Action Number thereof or, if the lodgment was made under the Trustee Act, the date of the Affidavit. If you are able to provide me with information of this nature then, upon receipt thereof, I shall be pleased to look further into the matter on your behalf.

There are two synagogues listed under Mile End and Bow District Synagogues, Harley Grove E.3 and 16, Jebb Street E.3.
