

Section A

[2] Elizabeth Solomon (Haines) . d 2 Nov 1852 . Aged 43. No headstone. Section A, row 2 (or row 5, depending on your map), plot 60, see below (not shown) (**wife of Mordecai**)

- *originally buried at Devonshire St on 2nd Nov 1852*
- *move to Rookwood 22nd March 1901 (Central Railway required the area)*
- *Headstones had been vandalised, so this is all we have*



[3] Myer Solomon d 7 Sept 1906. Aged 68. Section A Row 5 Plot 10 (OGS, 1/10) (**2nd of 8 children of Mordecai & Elizabeth Solomon**)

- *Had several houses at an early age (around 18yr)*
- *went to UK with his wife (Julia Rebecca) for a few years and 1 child was born there*
- *Held up in Little Wombat by a member of the Ben Hall gang*



[13] Louis Myers d 4 May 1869. aged 14 weeks. Section A Row 17 Grave 5/33 (not mentioned) (6th of 7 children of Mark & Jane Myers)



[10] Jane Solomon (married Mark Myers). d 14 Oct 1870. Aged 31. Section A Row 13 Grave 67 (OGS, 11/278) (3rd of 8 children of Mordecai & Elizabeth Solomon) (Mark buried in Section A Row 11 Plots 315/316)

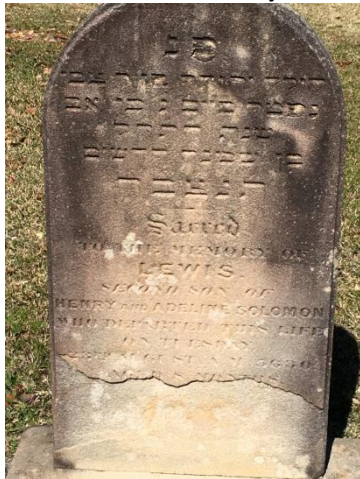
- her husband Mark, married again and had 4 children with Deborah Myers



[1] Mitchell Myers d 3 Oct 1862. Aged 6 yrs & 8 mths. Section A Row 13 No plot Number listed (OGS, 11/280) (1st of 14 children of George & Sarah Myers)



[8] Lewis Solomon. d 23 Aug 1870. Aged 8 months. Section A. Row 11 Grave 70 (OGS, 13/451) (3rd of 10 children of Henry & Adeline Solomon)



[4] Reginald Charles Solomon d 13 Dec 1859. Aged 15 mths. Section A Row 9 Grave 319 (OGS, 15/670) (8th of 10 children of Henry & Adeline Solomon)



[5] Horace Joseph Solomon. d 26 August 1888, Aged 2. Section A. Row 9. Grave 420/439 (OGS, 15/687) (5th of 6 children of Joseph & Adelaide Solomon)



[6] Henry Mordecai Solomon. d 8 March 1885. Aged 1. Section A, Row 9. Grave 511 (OGS, 15/700) (4th of 6 children of Joseph & Adelaide Solomon)

[17] George Mitchell d 14 April 1888 aged 6 weeks. Section A Row 10 Plot 494/509. (1st of 6 children of Mark and Elizabeth Mitchell)



[7] Isadore A Barnett. d 14 Feb 1888. Aged 4 months. Section A Row 10. Plot 524 – 537: grass plot no headstone (not shown) (8th of 10 children of Catherine & Isaac Barnett)



[9] Mordecai Solomon . d 9 Mar 1883. Aged 83. Section A. Row 11 Grave 415 (OGS, 13/509)

- *the inscription reads **"Sacred to the memory of Mordecai Solomon, who departed this life March 9th 1883, aged 83 years. May his soul rest in peace."***

"Here lies an old man with fulfilled life. Mordechai son of Meir. Went to the next world on 30 Adar 5643 at the age of 83.

May his soul be bound in the bond of eternal life. "

- *this gives some evidence that his father was "Myer Solomon*
- *Death certificate said time in colony 65yr i.e., arrived 1818*
- *Cemetery trust owns plots and they don't have refurbishment scheduled during next 5 years. If we can gain ownership it could be done, but complicated as you need all family member agreeing*

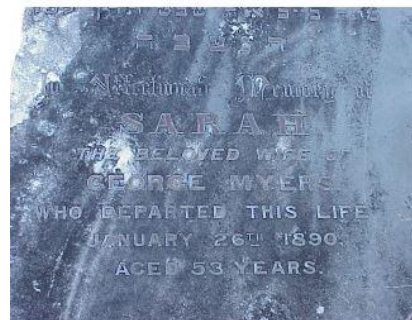


[11] Henry George Myers (Harry). d 22 Oct 1899. Aged 39. Section A Row 14 Plot/Grave 389 (not shown) (4th of 14 children of George & Sarah Myers)

- *no wife or children*



[12] Sarah Solomon (married George Myers) . d 26 Jan 1890. Aged 53. Section A Row 14. Plots 390 – 409. Next to George Myers (OGS, 10/208) (1st of 8 children of Mordecai & Elizabeth Solomon)



Section B

[14] Philip Annandale Mitchell. d 9 Aug 1892. Aged 2. Section B Row 8 Grave A84 (OGN, 8/84)
Grand-child of George & Sarah Myers (through the marriage of their daughter Elizabeth (d 1920) to Mark Mitchell (d 1922) (2nd of 6 children of Mark & Elizabeth Mitchell), and at the same location a memorial to Alan David Mitchell d 5th May 1915 in Helios Egypt aged 23 (4th of 6 children of Mark & Elizabeth Mitchell)

- *interesting to note that latest burials in this section were about 1902*



[15] Henry Solomon (married Adeline Joseph) d 20 Dec 1900. Aged 60. Section B Row 9. Grave D140 – 141 (OGN, 9/140) (**4th of 8 children of Mordecai & Elizabeth Solomon**) and **Adeline** d 11 May 1916. Aged 69. Section B Row 9. Grave D140 – 141 (OGN, 9/141)

- *lived with wife and family at Darlington House, City Rd next to father-in-law at Cypress Hall. These were significant buildings that no longer exist*
- *together with George and Henry Myers, he was the driving force behind Myers and Solomon*
- *Was a signatory to the act of incorporation the Montefiore Home and the first president*
- *involved in much philanthropic work*



[16] Catherine Solomon (married Isaac Barnett on 3 March 1869) d 10 April 1896 . Aged 49. Section B Row 12. Plot 394 (OGN, 12/394) (**7th of 8 children of Mordecai & Sarah Solomon**) (Isaac died 1912)
